Department of psychology, S.D.M.Govt.P.G.College, Doiwala was established in 2001. In 2017-18, the department was upgraded to postgraduate department. In first batch of PostGraduation 02 students got enrolled. In 2018-19, 4 students, 3 students in 2019-20, 8 students in 2020-21 and 5 students in 2021-22 were enrolled.

A) Activities (academic /extracurricular) of students: 100% first class results in batches 2017-19, 2018-20 and 2019-21 have been received in the post graduate program. Meenakshi Manwal (2017-19), Priyanka Rawat (2018-20) and Himani Raturi (2019-21) have received University Gold medals with 75.5%, 77.5% and 80% respectively. The students of department of psychology are continuously encouraged and engaged in extracurricular activities:

- 1) 4 students from MA IVsem became a part of competition organized by USERC in the college, where, Laxmi and Surekha Rana submitted their field reports on natural habitats of crows and Gujjars, respectively. Diksha and Priya participated in quiz competition.
- 2) Surekha Rana , Diksha, Priya & Vertika Agarwal (MA IVsem) won II prizes in competitions conducted under the umbrella of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat(EBSB) scheme.
- 3) Amit Kumar, BA (IIIyear), got selected in Navy on the basis of his expertise in shooting skills.
- 4) The departmental activities organized in the present session through Association of Psychology were essay competition, speech competition, workshop on counseling skills, mental health day celebration, poster competition and skits.

The students of the department of psychology actively participate in the sports and various cultural events organized by the college.

B) Activities done by the faculty of the department:
