Functions of Examination Cell

- To prepare an Annual Examination calendar for Academic year according to university guidelines
- Plans the Seating arrangement for the Examination.
- Notifies the student and staff about the examination dates and time schedule.
- Takes necessary steps for distribution of answer sheets and confidentiality of question papers.
- Maintains all records pertaining to examination.

- Prepares consolidated marks register along with University and Principal copy.
- Address the grievances of students related to Examination issues.

The Evaluation System

- The ratio of external and internal assessment is 80:20 for PG Semester system.
- UG Examination system is running on yearly/Annual basis from 2019-20.
- The Examination Cell asks all the departments to submit the completed internal awards sheets for each subject for PG (Semester system) and practical marks for UG (yearly).
- A minimum of 75% of attendance in a semester/Year is mandatory for eligibility to take the Semester End and Yearly examination.
- Students having less than 75% attendance in a semester are not permitted to appear in the Semester-End examination.
- If a student has 60 % to 75% attendance he/she may be permitted to write the examination at the discretion of the Principal, under the following conditions
 - a) Their prolonged absence is due to illness or other exigencies of life and they have been regular to classes other times.
 - b) In all previous semester, student's average attendance should be 75% or more.
 - Back paper examination will be conducted once in a year according to University schedule.
 - All Question papers are prepared by the Subject expert nominated by the university.

Note- For every 20 students two invigilators are allowed according to university guidelines. One helping invigilator allowed for every 80 students.
